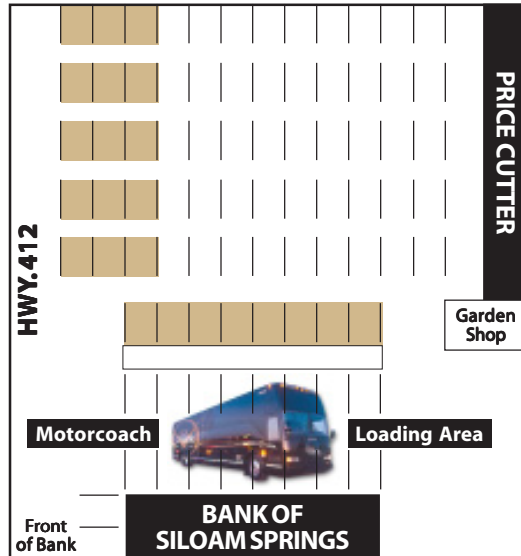


Parking at the Bank



Travel Masters will park & depart from the Bank of Siloam Springs parking lot located at 1660 West U.S. Hwy. 412. Please park in the top section of the Price Cutter parking lot. Gold Shaded areas above are the correct parking spots. Please park in these spots to avoid having to move before departure.

"Travel Info" Sheet

A "TRAVEL INFO" SHEET will need to be completed before departure. This provides helpful details on medical history, medications & emergency contact numbers. See the sheet that is included with this brochure. If a medical sheet is not included, we have your information on file. If changes occur, such as new medications or emergency contacts please let us know. A Travel Release form must be signed by all travelers before travel can be taken.

Cruise Excursions:

If you'd like any help pre-booking an Excursion in Key West or in the Bahamas please let us know and we'll be happy to assist you. There normally is a deadline to pre-book 2 weeks before a ship sails. You can also book excursions onboard the ship at the Excursion Desk.

The Cruise Ship is CASHLESS!

Please make sure to bring the Credit Card that you gave us for your online registration. Your Cabin Key Card is attached to your Credit Card and anything you will need to purchase you can do so by giving them your Cabin Key Card. If you would lose your Cabin Key Card please notify the Guest Service desk on Deck 7 as soon as possible.

Cruise Ship - Departure Talk

You will hear (and see) them talk about a "Departure Talk". The Travel Masters will have their own separate "Departure Talk". Marsha & Frank will inform you of our meeting time and place.

Dress:

Casual clothes are appropriate for most activities and travel. Please see your "Cruise Information for suggested attire on the Cruise Ship.

We suggest "layering" as the TEMPERATURES will vary outside and on the motorcoach. Temperatures should be very nice on this tour. But as always you might want to pack a sweater, jacket or light coat for cooler days or to have on the motorcoach. Additionally, you may wish to pack quality sunglasses an umbrella or raincoat and waterproof shoes in case you encounter some "liquid" sunshine! Travelers should have comfortable walking shoes, since nobody can really enjoy their sightseeing with aching feet. If you wear glasses or contact lenses, it is advisable to include an extra pair.

Seating:

There are no seats assigned. For extended trips, a seat rotation plan will be explained and followed. This allows everyone to meet more of the travelers on the tour. The escorts or drivers cannot make exceptions for seating in the front of the motorcoach out of fairness to the other travelers.

Nesting:

We do allow Travelers to have a seat in the back of the motorcoach and "nest" as we call it. Meaning they will not follow seat rotation and can have the seat to "nest" for the duration of the tour. Please let us know if you would like to "nest".

If you would like to "Nest" please let us know as soon as you know and we'll mark seats for you in the back of the motorcoach.

Smoking:

For the comfort of all travelers, smoking is not permitted on the motorcoach. Rest stops for smoking and stretching are scheduled regularly.

Drinks & Food:

Each morning we will have a bottle of water for each passenger. Please take one bottle as you get onto the motorcoach. Due to scheduling we will not get water out other than morning departures.

We make frequent stops on Travel Masters Tours. Please feel free to bring on soft drinks, water or any snacks to enjoy while we're traveling.

Luggage Handling:

One piece of checked luggage is allowed per person (not to exceed 50 lbs.) Enclosed is a luggage tag for your checked bag.

Carry-on bags may be taken and handled by the passenger. They can go underneath the motorcoach.

When we are in Savannah we will hand out luggage tags to put on your handled suitcase that will be required by the Cruise Ship.

Note: Packing for Ease of Traveling

We suggest taking a carry-on which can hold your PJ'S, tooth brush, tooth paste, make-up etc. This way you can prepare for bed while waiting for your luggage to be delivered to your room.

DO NOT SET OUT CARRY-ON FOR LUGGAGE PICKUP: Carry-ons are your own responsibility (you'll need to take them to and from the motorcoach).

Please feel free to also bring on the motorcoach a small tote, purse or camera bag. They may be stored above you in the storage compartments.

Odds & Ends:

Being on time is very helpful to a group, it keeps the entire itinerary going as planned and is appreciated by everyone. Times can vary, so make sure to mark changes or fill in times in the blanks provided.
